POSITION OVERVIEW

A Workshop Facilitator will assist the BKT directors in the presentation and facilitation of workshops to various audiences including youth, young adults, parents, and leaders.

REPORTS TO

The Directors and Workshop Team Leader.

TIME COMMITMENT

2 hours minimum per week, ideally on a selected day of the week.

This position is also expected to attend fortnightly team meetings, and the occasional in person team planning session.

Note: there is flexibility on times if work/family commitments are an issue.

SPECIAL GIFTS AND TALENTS PREFERRED

- + A vibrant, humble and ever-maturing Christian faith.
- + A goal-oriented individual who is a mature, organized, self-starter with a warm personality and strong communication skills.
- + An individual who easily makes connections with people and has had previous experience in youth ministry.
- + An individual with previous public-speaking and workshop facilitation experience.

QUALITIES

- + Prioritizes a strong relationship with God, focusing on this in their day to day. They understand the importance of faith to their lives and intimacy with God through this.
- + Doesn't profess to know all the answers. They approach leadership with grace, humility, and an eagerness to learn.

- + Brings a tone of joyful enthusiasm and Godliness to their role. + Is an active member of their own local church, serving in some capacity.
- + Pursues Godliness in all things and does not participate in sexual immorality, drunkenness, gossip and/or any other immoral behaviour, understanding their influence as a representative of BKT on the teenage audience BKT has.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- + Fully and proudly embracing the BKT ethos and mission in your personal life.
- + Lead dynamic workshops for BKT audiences, utilizing a BKT Program Curriculum.
- + Ensure curriculum fidelity by facilitating curriculum as designed and working towards developing a mastery of the content.
- + Maintain a working knowledge of community resources, staying current with church/school partnerships, and incoming referrals.
- + Engage with relevant stakeholders at events when not presenting to build relationship and engagement.
- + Work collaboratively with the Director(s) leading the workshop to ensure all needs are addressed.
- + Plan and coordinate with co-leaders of workshops to ensure curriculum needs are met before and throughout the workshop series.
- + Aid in on-going program development by participating in team events, attending training sessions, and participating in peer reviews ensuring you stay current with curriculum updates.
- + Utilise networks when confidently advocating for BKT, engaging a broader audience for resources and referrals.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

The Workshop Facilitator will engage in team training that will familiarise them with the BKT ethos and mission and develop their presentation and facilitation skills.

TERM OF APPOINTMENT

6 months to begin with. The experience will then be evaluated together with our directors and future involvement will be determined with prayerful consideration and individual preference.

REQUIREMENTS

- + Induction training with our Directors.
- + Completion of BKT child safety training.
- + Provision of the necessary compliance checks (i.e. police check and Working with Children Check).
